GROUND RULES: Only actual contestant and one companion allowed gate access.

ALL CONTESTANTS - All contestants are required to wear PRCA patch while competing.

ALL EVENTS - The "30 hour replacement rule" will be in effect. See Rodeo Entry Information page of the business journal.

ALL EVENTS - Re-entries will be accepted for available positions on Fri., July 13 between 10 AM and 12 PM. See Rodeo Entry Information page of the business journal

TRADE DEADLINE - Thurs., July 12 at 5PM. All confirmed trades will be final and will be processed each business day at 5 PM by PROCOM.

ALL EVENTS - "No conflict" will be guaranteed at all Gold and Silver tour rodeos (if possible), as long as the contestant does not create the conflict by giving a conflicting preference.

"No conflict" will not be guaranteed for the team roping event at Salinas and Spanish Fork. 15 teams will be placed in each of the first two "back to back" groups at Spanish Fork on July 20 and 21, which conflicts with the 2nd and 3rd go-rounds at Salinas. 25 teams will be placed in the second two "back to back" groups at Spanish Fork on July 23 and 24 which do not conflict with Salinas.

Teams who are not entered in Salinas and are originally placed in the 3rd and 4th

"back to back" groups at Spanish Fork may be moved and placed in the 1st and 2nd "back to back" groups to accommodate as many as possible of the teams who are conflicted with Salinas. A contestant should not use the "No Same Day" preference in this instance unless he wants the possibility of being drawn out. (Does not include conflicts with SR positions).

ALL EVENTS - If a contestant notifies a turn-out prior to the 30-hour deadline for his scheduled competition time, turn-out fines will be waived, if and only if he is replaced.

EXEMPTIONS FROM QUALIFICATIONS -

Contestants must notify PROCOM at the time of entry if they are claiming an exemption from qualification. Anyone claiming an exemption must have entered and paid fees at a minimum of twenty (20) PRCA sanctioned rodeos held during the 2011 rodeo year, unless the contestant qualifies for a medical exemption. Contestants claiming medical exemptions must have been injured at least six (6) months during the 2011 rodeo year. Contestant must not have entered and paid fees at more than twenty (20) PRCA sanctioned rodeos held during the 2011 rodeo year. A letter from a licensed physician on doctor's letterhead bearing the doctor's name, address and phone number, must be received by the PRCA National Office prior to entry opening.

TD - Stock charge \$5 per go-round.

TD - Scoreline will be 4' less than box.

SLACK ORDER - Will be SW, TR, TD.

TE - The qualifications for circuit money won will be 50% from 2012 circuit money won and 50% from 2011 circuit money won. (If a contestant qualifies in both categories, 2012 and 2011 circuit money won, he will assume the position among the 2012 circuit money won category for all three timed events). This applies to circuit qualifications only. If there are not enough contestants in the current year circuit money won category to fill the allotted positions, the remaining positions will be filled with contestants from the previous year circuit money won category.

QUALIFICATIONS: BB & SB - 48 minimum entries. No compensation. No slack.

BR - 60 minimum entries. No compensation. No slack.

TD, SW, TR - 80 minimum entries (or teams). No compensation. Two go-rounds, back to back. The first go-round each back to back group will be run during afternoon slack. The committee will have the option of designating two contestants (or teams) to compete during the performance for their second go-round. The committee must notify PROCOM which two contestants or teams are to be placed in the performances by 5 PM (Mountain Time) the day after the first go-round trade deadline. Also, the

contestants with the top ten fastest times from the first go-round will be placed in the performance (slowest time will run first, fastest time will run last). The number of contestants placed in the performance will not exceed 10, unless either one or both of the committee designated contestants are not among the top ten from the first go-round (in this case the maximum could be 11 or 12). If the committee designated contestants are among the top 10, they will assume their positions based on their first go-round time. If they are not among the top 10, they will run first in the performance (if neither of the two designated contestants are among the top 10, their positions will be based on the reverse order of their first go-round positions) If splits result in more than 10, a random draw will determine which contestants will compete in the performance and which will compete in slack. The order of competition of ties from the first go-round will also be determined by random draw. If there are not 10 qualified times from the first go-round to fill the performance, the remaining positions will be filled by contestants based on the reverse order of their first go-round positions (only contestants who competed in the first go-round will be placed in the performance).

The remaining contestants (not placed in

the performance) will run their second go-round in slack immediately following the completion of the first go-round in reverse order of their first go-round position. The order of the draw will be the same as the competition order.

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POST AT RODEO - REQUESTED BY COMMITTEE - NOT ENFORCED BY THE PRCA

1. TD & TR - Contestants are requested to enter box from the back.
2. TE - No other contestant in the arena and must exit before the next contestant performs.
3. Stalls are available free of charge on a first come first served basis.
4. Please do not tie horses in any arenas, pens or trees.
5. No electric fences allowed on grounds

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
