Non-Returned Items

Spanish Fork City continues to suffer losses due to library materials which are not returned. While an individual item may seem inconsequential, the accumulative total is an unnecessary expense to the taxpayers of the City.

Utah Code Annotated §76-6-803.30 makes it a crime to fail to return library materials. Spanish Fork City intends to send one late notice then file library theft criminal charges against those who fail to return library materials.

Notice of Election

Notice is hereby given that Spanish Fork City will hold a municipal election this fall to elect to four year terms: 1 Mayor and 2 Councilmembers. Given a sufficient number of candidates, a primary election will be held on **October 4, 2005**, with the municipal general election being held on **November 8, 2005**. Qualifications to be a candidate are:

1. Be a United States citizen at time of filing,
2. Be at least 18 years old,
3. Be a registered voter of the municipality,
4. Be a resident of the municipality for 12 consecutive months before **November 8th**.

A qualified candidate may file a Declaration of Candidacy statement, or a Petition may be filed in behalf of a qualified person. The filing must be in person with the City Recorder. The filing period is from **July 15, 2005** to 5:00 P.M. on **August 15, 2005**. All candidates for election are subject to campaign financial statement disclosure regulations.
