The budget includes a transfer of funds which cannot be defined as reasonable allocation of costs between funds. This transfer includes funds from the Electric Fund to the Golf Fund in the amount of \$208,000.

RESIDENTIAL UTILITY EQUAL PAY PROGRAM

January 2007

We are now offering the Equal Payment Plan to our Residential Utility Customers. The equal payment plan is based on the past 12 months total utility bill. Customers will be able to sign up for this program twice a year, February and August, and we must receive your sign-up form before the 20th of February. Your account will be reviewed and recalculated every six months and based on the recalculation, adjustments may be made to your monthly equal pay amount. In order to stay on the program, the equal pay amount must be paid on or before the 20th of each month. To qualify for Equal Pay you must have had service in your name, at the same service location, for the prior 12 month period. You must also have no late payments for the same 12 month period. To sign up for the Equal Pay Program, please answer the questions below and return the form with your utility bill.
