**Sod Will Be Made Available at the North Park...Read On**

During the months of September and October, the much anticipated changes at the North Park will begin. First, you will see City Crews salvage much of what is in the park. Those items may be used in other park facilities or held until the North Park is reconstructed at its new location just Northwest of the present park. That salvage work will begin after **Labor Day** and don't be alarmed when you see some things begin to disappear; this is a part of the relocation process.

Once the City has completed the salvage process, there is a part of the park the City would like to make available to you. Beginning **Saturday, September 8**, the grass at the North Park will be available for the public to cut and relocate to your homes. In addition to the grass,

the chain link fence will also be available for the taking.

This sod will be available for one week only, ending on **Saturday, September 15**. As a part of the City's salvage work, the water to all grass will be shut off before the 8th, and all sprinklers will be removed. Although the grass may begin to brown, it should recover with healthy watering after it is placed. After **September 15**, the park will be closed to the public until it is relocated and rebuilt.

To preserve order during this time, the City invites you to rent **YOUR OWN** sod cutter to retrieve whatever grass you will need. As you cut the sod, be courteous to those around you. Remember that they are your neighbors and a part of

the community. Also, use caution and remember to operate all machinery safely and to follow instructions as they may be given. Also, remember that no items may be taken from the park before **Saturday, September 8**. If anyone is caught taking items before this date, you will be turned over to the police.

We invite you to take the next few weeks to identify areas in your yards where you may be able to use this sod. We also invite you to gather as friends and neighbors to identify ways in which you may use this sod to help others around you, creating service opportunities where you live. Then, bring a sod cutter and gather what you need. It's that simple. But remember, wait until **September 8th**.


