ITINERANT MERCHANTS

Spanish Fork City staff often receives questions from entrepreneurs who are interested in selling goods on a seasonal or temporary basis. Temporary sales or display of goods are allowed in Spanish Fork City provided that the purveyor (seller) first obtain a Spanish Fork City Business License. The Itinerant Merchant License is good for a

maximum of 120 calendar days and is subject to the criteria listed in the Spanish Fork City Municipal Code Section 5.04.110 D.
