SFCN will be making necessary changes to the television channel lineup during the next year in preparation for the new all-digital SFCN. Notifications of published channel changes will be sent in this newsletter, however some customers have been viewing some digital or even HD channels at unpublished numbers, usually in the 132.x to 135.x channel range. SFCN will move these channels so that they match the published SFCN channel lineup and after this change, there will only be one set of SFCN channel numbers.

BUSINESS LICENSE CHANGES FOR NEW YEAR

There are a few changes that are occurring in the City's Business License program.

The first change involves the City's methodology for calculating Business License Fees. The new methodology results in the establishment of a uniform fee for all businesses in the City. Most businesses will see their annual fee change as all businesses will be required to pay a \$40 fee each year. This amount will be reflected in a renewal letter that will be sent the last week in November. It is hoped that simplifying the City's fee structure will make the City easier to work with and make Spanish Fork an even more attractive place for businesses to locate.

A second change involves services the City will be offering online. Spanish Fork City has contracted with CitizenServe to provide many of the City's license services online. It is anticipated that this service will be available the first week in December and that a specific go-live date will be included in the renewal letter and with next month's newsletter.
