**BEWARE OF UTILITY TELEPHONE SCAMS**

Spanish Fork City is aware of incidents in which an unknown caller has called from various (801) numbers to businesses and residents stating that payment for past utilities has not been received, and if payment is not received now that the utilities will be shut off. The caller then states that they can accept credit card or checks over the phone. Often times the caller indicates that they are from Rocky Mountain Power. Be aware that the City does not provide power through Rocky Mountain Power, so this phone call is probably fraudulent.

The Police Department is currently investigating this fraudulent activity. Please notify the department if you receive similar phone calls at 801.804.4700. You may also contact Spanish Fork City Utilities to check your account status.

For your information, Spanish Fork City notifies residents and businesses regarding past due utility bills, including electricity, by mailing out two separate notifications. If payment is still not received by the due date, a pre-recorded phone call is made to all delinquent customers the day before shut-offs.
