

KICK THE DUST UP AT FIESTA DAYS



Construction Improvements

Now that the Center Street Bridge is open and 400 North is widened, there are a few new projects to be aware of. These are big ones!

From now through mid-July, UDOT will be resurfacing Main Street AND 400 North. These projects will mill and overlay these State roads and apply a seal coat south of 300 South. This project will also add an additional lane at 1000 North Main Street to help the congestion in that area.

The road realignment project has started at 2550 East and Canyon Road where a stoplight and turn lanes will be added to a new 4-way intersection. For updates check the Construction Work Map located at www.spanishfork.org.



City Cemetery Streets Renovation


