SFCN Dropping Pay-Per-View

SFCN is dropping carriage of all its Pay-Per-View channels. Indemand dropped two of the four channels we were carrying and have no replacement options. Since the advent of Netflix, Hulu, Amazon, etc., PPV sales have dropped below a sustainable level. Channels 702 and 703 were dropped last month because the signal was pulled by Indemand and we will discontinue carriage of 700 and 701 on September 1, 2016. Construction Update

Main Street construction north of 300 S is completed. We are excited to have the new lane at 1000 N. Work will now begin to resurface Main St from 300 S south. That should be completed by the middle of August.

UDOT is about to commence the final overlay of 400 N and then that project will be completed as well.

Crews are working on the utilities at 2550 E Canyon Rd intersection. Soon road construction will begin and then a new traffic signal installed. This project is expected to go through the month of October.

The storm drain project in the subdivision north of Canyon Elementary was started at the end of July and is expected to be completed the middle of October.


We all can work together to do these simple things to make it less expensive to treat our wastewater before it goes to Utah Lake.
