TEXT TO 911

We are pleased to announce residents anywhere in Utah County can text "911" on their cell phones and connect with a 911 dispatcher.

Speaking directly to a 911 dispatcher is always the best and fastest way to get help in an emergency or to report a crime in progress. If you can call 911 for help, please do, but for those times when you can't call, there is now "Text to 911".



Texting 911 enables citizens to communicate with emergency dispatchers if they are unable to call 911. Cases of abuse, burglary and robbery have been successfully reported across the country by callers who have been able to text 911 without tipping off a suspect. We are happy to be able to offer this life saving service to our citizens.

This announcement covers all cities and all of the unincorporated areas in Utah County. As the public safety professionals in Utah County we are always working to improve our ability to respond to emergencies to help keep you safe.

HEPATITIS A IS STOPPED AT A BATHROOM SINK

With all the talk about Hepatitis A, we wanted share two ways to break the cycle of spreading this disease.



1. Get Vaccinated - The best way to prevent Hepatitis A is through the Hepatitis A vaccine, which is given as two shots, six months apart. Vaccinations are available at the Utah County Health Department, but you may be able to receive a vaccination from your primary care physician or a pharmacy in a more timely manner.

2. Wash Hands - The Hepatitis A virus is transmitted primarily when an uninfected person ingests food or drink that has been contaminated with the feces of an infected person. Washing your hands thoroughly after using the bathroom helps to prevent the spreading of Hepatitis A.



RIVER TRAIL 2ND PHASE

Spanish Fork City plans to build five additional trails by fall of 2018 to improve connectivity and extend the length of the Spanish Fork River Trail system. This project includes trails at 1550 West (I-15 Trail), south of the Spanish Fork Fairgrounds to 300 East. (Fairgrounds Trail), in the area of River Bottom Road and 1100 East (Poplar Lane Trail), the Fairway Drive area (Dripping Rock), and up to the Spanish Oaks Reservoir.

Phase One of this trail project was completed in 2015. Phase Two will build two new bridges in the Dripping Rock Trail area, including a suspension-style bridge over the Spanish Fork River. The project is funded through the Mountainland Association of Governments (MAG) at a cost of approximately \$3 million.
