



# Curbside Recycling

## Program Details

Spanish Fork City residents will enjoy the City's first-ever curbside recycling program beginning June, 2009. Once signed up for the service, Allied Waste will deliver a blue recycling bin to your home and give you the following information: a list of acceptable and unacceptable recycling items; your recycling pickup day; and customer service contact information.

## Pickup

Your recycling pickup day may fall on a day other than your garbage pickup day. Recycling will be picked up once every two weeks on a single side of your street. Residents who have signed up for the program will start receiving their recycling bins in the middle of May.

## Signup

Signup for recycling today! Simply come in person or call the Utility Office at 804-4501. The service will be added to your monthly utility bill.

## Cost

Recycling comes at a cost, but so does not recycling. To collect, transport, process, and ship your recycling, garbage companies and the City must charge a minimal fee:

Recycling Collection: \$5.00  
Fuel Surcharge: \$1.00\*\*
