Avoid Overhead Power Lines

While working on a ladder on a building outside, make sure to look up for power lines and stay as far away from them as possible. Do not get closer than 10 ft. to any power line. It is best to use wood or fiberglass ladders and carry ladders down by your side, not with the end up.

Do not trim trees around power lines, call the City at (801) 804-4541. Do not plant new trees under power lines. If you see any downed power line, stay away, keep others away, and call 911.

Green Waste Disposal

Residents can download three (3) free vouchers a year that allow them to take loads of green waste to the transfer station (2450 W. 400 S., Springville). These vouchers give individuals a \$10 credit for each load (same as a pickup truck sized load of covered green waste (440 lbs)).

Bring a **paper copy** of the voucher to the transfer station when you drop off your green waste. Electronic vouchers won't be accepted.
