Sprinklers

Make sure water to sprinklers is TURNED OFF. It is recommended you turn off the water to your sprinkler system at the meter or stop and waste before the city system is energized. Find a how-to video at spanishfork.org/pi. Once the outdoor water system is pressurized, you can turn on the water and manually test each sprinkler zone. If you have a sprinkler system filter, check to make sure it is clean. Replace the lid to the box when you are done. To report a leaking or broken valve or handle, call (801) 804-4550.

Utah County Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Event

Instead of a single-day event, county residents will be able to take household hazardous waste to the transfer station (2450 W 400 S, Springville) for free all year. The following items will be accepted:

- Pesticides
- Fertilizer
- Oils
- Paint and Solvents
- Electronics
- Paper Shredding
- Needles
- Medications

2023 Spring Clean-Up

The 2023 Spring Clean-up is from April 24-29 and May 1-6. Large dumpsters will be placed at five locations: Abbie Court Park, Centennial Park, Downtown (300 N 100 E), Sierra Park, & Sports Park. The dumpsters are open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Acceptable items include rocks, green waste, trees, garbage, toys, and plastic. Unacceptable items include tires, refrigerators, freezers, AC units with freon, oils, chemicals, flammable liquids, and electronics. Dumpsters will not be out on Sunday.
