THANK YOU FOR SELECTING THE MOUNTAIN COUNTRY PAVILION FOR YOUR EVENT. PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY AND FOLLOW ALL GUIDELINES.

- Cleaning deposit will be refunded after rental date. Patrons are required to clean the pavilion. If a group meets the
 conditions and park guidelines stipulated below, their complete cleaning deposit will be returned. If guidelines are not
 followed, or if group does not clean the pavilion, the cleaning deposit will be retained. If cost exceeds the amount of
 the cleaning deposit, patron will be required to pay for any incurred expenses of cleaning or repair.
- Patrons may NOT arrive more than 15 minutes early or remain 15 minutes longer than your rental block time.
- The pavilion has electrical outlets and lights.
- Gas grills are available to use for an additional charge of \$10.00.
- The pavilion has 15 tables. Please do not remove the tables from the pavilion. If you re-arrange the tables, they must be returned to their original position.
- Groups are responsible for basic clean-up of the pavilion and the immediate area around the pavilion.
 Groups should remove all decorations, including tape and clean-up all of the garbage. Bring a push broom.
- NO INFLATABLES (bounce houses etc). NO pinatas. NO glitter or confetti of any type including glitter
 and confetti balloons allowed at the pavilion or in the park (helium balloons are allowed). NO water slides
 or dunk tanks. NO exceptions!
- In accordance with Spanish Fork Municipal Code, 9.04.030(C)(2), alcohol consumption is prohibited in any city park.
- In accordance with Utah County Board of Health, smoking and vaping is prohibited in any city park.
- NO DOGS or OTHER ANIMALS allowed in the park with the exception of SERVICE DOGS which are allowed, however, this does not include emotional support animals.
- **NO DRIVING** on the grass or sidewalks. Please make sure that anything you bring can be carried to and from the pavilion from the parking area. **Please plan ahead!**
- NO FIREWORKS allowed in the park. This includes the 4th and 24th of July celebrations.
- This pavilion is located above the Spanish Oaks Reservoir. Fishing and swimming are both allowed at the reservoir, however there is not a lifeguard on duty. There is a walking path around the reservoir, a campground with tent sites above the pavilion and a variety of trails near the campground. Drop boxes are available at the campground for camping fees. .
- No refund of rental fee will be given due to inclement weather. In the case of severe weather conditions, a pavilion may be re-scheduled for a later date in the same season. Reservations <u>may not</u> be carried over to the next year. Cancellations up to thirty days in advance of rental date will be refunded. If a group cancels closer than thirty days prior to their rental, their spot must be re-reserved in order for the group canceling to receive a refund of the rental fee. All refunds will be less a \$10.00 processing fee.
